Pumping continues

Mataura residents are reminded that emergency pumping from the Mataura River is continuing, albeit intermittently. This is due to the lack of water flowing into the Pleura Dam. We are reviewing the situation daily. While the river water is treated at the town's water treatment station, we have placed a water tanker outside the service centre for residents concerned about the taste of the water.
