

Tulloch Park redevelopment begins

Work is expected to begin on Stage One of the Tulloch Park redevelopment in Matura next week.

Stage one involves establishing a jogging track, fitness stations, a pump track, a playground, asphalt walkways and timber decks.

The Matura Community Board and Gore District Council asks the public to keep away from the construction area.

During construction the following will be closed:

- Playground access from SH1 and Glendhu Road
- The gravel car park behind the old pool and rugby field
- Tulloch Park public toilets (Queens Park public toilets are open 24/7)

The carpark immediately to the south of the old pool is still available for use.

Weather permitting, the work should be finished by December.

Changes to visiting our specialist staff

A reminder we are making some changes that will affect visitors to the civic administration building.

On those days, customers will need to go to the ground floor reception area, where one of our team will contact the best person to deal with their enquiry.

Appointments will be essential on Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays.

The changes reflect the fact our staff deal with customers on multiple channels, such as email or digitally, and not just face-to-face.

We appreciate there may be some challenges as we work through these changes and welcome any feedback. We will also be carrying out a customer service survey later this month.
