

GORE TOWN BELT MANAGEMENT PLAN: PROPOSED REVIEW

Pursuant to Section 41(5)(a) of the Reserves Act 1977, notice is hereby given that the Gore District Council intends to conduct a review of the approved Management Plan for the Gore Town Belt.

The current plan was adopted following a public consultation process in 1996, and is due for review to ensure it keeps abreast of changing circumstances and needs in the community.

Prior to commencing this review the Council invites interested persons or organisations to provide written suggestions on any issues or factors that should be addressed in the Management Plan.

A copy of the current management plan, which contains a description of the lands included in the Gore Town Belt, can be obtained from the ground floor reception of the Gore Civic Administration Building, Civic Avenue, Gore, the Gore Public Library or the Mataura Service Centre.
