BOIL WATER NOTICE - UPDATE

This is an update to the occupier regarding the “Boil Water Notice” that has been placed on the north-western area of the Mataura water supply. This is specific to all consumers north of Glendhu Road.

- The issue with chlorine has not been created by the work on Pleura Dam; it is to do with the network pipe work.
- A section of water main will be replaced between Glendhu Road and Dacre Street.
- Trenching work will begin next week in the grassed area west of State Highway 1.
- The Council is waiting on fibre optic cable location before we can start trenching.

PLEASE NOTE THAT THE “BOIL WATER NOTICE” REMAINS IN PLACE UNTIL FURTHER NOTICE.

The area affected by this notice is shown on the back of the page.

Please boil all water that is intended for drinking or cooking until further notice.

- Daily testing is continuing to monitor water quality and shall continue until chlorine levels can be maintained in this area of the reticulation.
- This “Boil Water Notice” will remain in place until the Council is satisfied that the issue has been resolved.
