

The Gore Aquatic Centre is a family friendly facility. To ensure the safety of users and maximum enjoyment for all, please read and follow our conditions of entry.

RISK AND RESPONSIBILITY

You must only swim where you are medically able and physically fit to swim.

SUPERVISION REQUIREMENTS

In accordance with Poolsafe Guidelines:

- All children under 5 years of age must have a person aged 16 years and over in the water and ACTIVELY SUPERVISING* them.
- Children aged 5 years to 7 years must be ACTIVELY SUPERVISED* by a person aged 16 years and over.
- *Active supervision means the person must be able to provide immediate assistance.

Lifeguards are an important part of ensuring swimmers' safety but they cannot and do not replace the close supervision of a parent or guardian.

YOU ARE YOUR CHILD'S LIFEGUARD - KEEP THEM SAFE

PROHIBITED USE / ITEMS

The Gore Multisports Complex is a smoke free area. No bottles, glassware or metal utensils are allowed in the pool area.

No alcohol or drugs are permitted on the premises.

No person suspected of being under the influence of alcohol or drugs is permitted on the premises.

No pets are permitted in the Gore Multisports Complex with the exception of guide dogs.

PROHIBITED ACTIVITIES

Damage to the Council's property and abusive or offensive behaviour are not permitted. These may lead to prosecution.

Only persons approved by the Gore Aquatic Centre management are permitted to conduct swim lessons or coaching sessions.

GENERAL

Please be mindful of other patrons when using our family friendly facilities and mind your language. Do not run, bomb, push or litter.

PERSONAL HYGIENE

All toddlers and babies who are not toilet trained must wear approved swim nappies.

All patrons are encouraged to shower thoroughly before entering the pool.

USE OF CHANGING ROOMS

Only families and people with a disability are allowed to use the changing rooms specifically designated for them.

School age children are to use the same gender changing rooms. They can use a family changing room when accompanied by a parent or caregiver over the age of 16 years.

No recording devices or mobile phones are to be used in the changing rooms.

DRESS CODE FOR SWIMMERS

Recognised swimwear must be worn.

Approved swimming shorts should be knee length or above the knee.

Underwear, boxer shorts, cargo pants and jeans are not acceptable.

A clean T-shirt may be worn over approved swimwear in special circumstances. These include aqua jogging, teaching swimming and health reasons. Please check with pool staff.

If you have a medical condition that could put you or others in danger while swimming, please notify pool staff.
