Name of Applicant: Taha Fertilizer Industries Limited (on behalf of Taha Asia Pacific and Taha Fertilizer Industries Limited)

Location of Site: 109, 116-130 Kana Street, Mataura. Gore District

Description of Application: To store a class 6 and 9 hazardous substance above the quantities permitted for sites in the Industrial Zone for a period of 2 years and subject to a programmed removal to be tied to the establishment of alternative storage facilities. No further product will be brought to the site for storage.
