T3	<i>Abies concolor</i> <i>candicans</i> (Colorado White Fir)	Gore Gardens, Gore	Planted in 1991 by Mayor I R Tulloch to commemorate the formation of Gore District Council in November 1989.
T4	<i>Mespilus germanica</i> <i>Medlar</i>	Gore Gardens, Gore	Planted in 1988 by Mr I D Gilchrist to honour his services as the long time Superintendent of Reserves.
T5	<i>Quercus robur</i> (English Oak)	Gore Gardens, Gore	Planted in 1911 to commemorate the coronation of King George V.
T6	<i>Ulmus glabra pendula</i> (Bowler Elm)	Gore Gardens, Gore	Planted circa 1916. Donated to the public of Gore by M E Bowler.
T7	<i>Sequoiadendron giganteum</i> 'wellingtonia'	Gore Gardens, Gore	Planted in 1906. The tallest tree in Gore, the tree is a landmark in the town of Gore.
