- Tuesday 1 June the Council hears feedback on the draft 10YP
- Tuesday 15 June the Council deliberate on feedback and makes any changes
- Late June Adoption of 10YP

Gore Library Temporary Closure

The Gore Library is closed until Thursday 6 May to allow staff to relocate to new temporary premise at the Encounter New Life Church, in Jacob Street, off Hokonui Drive.

The James Cumming Wing is also closed to the public.

Books due during the closed period (17 April to 6 May) will be automatically extended until Monday 10 May.

The after-hours returns bin will be moved at the same time as the relocation. Library users are asked to please hold onto books until the library reopens or return them to the Mataura Library.

The Church will remain open for services and other activities, using spaces separate to the library.

The library will be open normal hours. However, the winter Sunday service has been cancelled.
