Water Supply Disruption for Gore

The Council will be stopping water flow from the East Gore reservoir to all of Gore on Wednesday 10 February, at around 11.00pm. The reservoir will be isolated for about six hours.

The Hilbre Avenue water treatment plant will continue to operate during this time. However, we expect the work will result in a drop in water pressure to parts of the network. Some households and businesses may have no water during this period.

When water flow is restored, properties may experience discoloured water. If this happens, residents should run a tap for a few minutes. If the water continues to be discoloured by mid-morning, residents should contact our customer service team, phone **209-0330**.

Temporary Street Closures
