Road closure

Abernethy Contracting will be felling some large trees, as weather permits, along Waimea Street. The work will take place sometime between Monday 14 June and Monday 21 June.

This will require the street, between the intersection with Norton Street and State Highway 94, to be closed periodically between 9:00am and 11:30am.

Homeowner notification for wastewater inspections

Later this month the 3 Waters team will start inspecting Gore and Mataura's wastewater network using CCTV.

Before each inspection, contractors will be cleaning wastewater pipelines using a high-pressure water blaster. This can cause turbulence and fluctuations in the air pressure in a property's wastewater system.

It will be important for residents to keep their toilet lids closed while work is being carried out their area.

To stay informed, download the Council's app Antenno. There will be a weekly notification to let residents know when there's work in their area.

The contractors will also be doing letter drops to affected residents a couple of days before they arrive in an area.

Building Control Inspections

The Council's building control team would like to remind customers wanting a building inspection to make a booking at least two days before the inspections is required.

All inspection requests are placed on a waiting list and one of the team tries to arrange an inspection at a time to suit both parties. So, please don't leave it until the last minute to get in touch. Phone **209-0330** to make your booking.
