#### **Consent applications**

People needing a building or resource consent before the Christmas / New Year break need to lodge their application with the Council by **Friday 19 November**.

And don't forget, it's important to make sure applications have all the necessary information. If not, the application may not be accepted, or processing may be suspended until the information is provided.

## Special licence applications

Anyone wanting to sell alcohol at events and occasions need to obtain a special licence. This includes events such as Christmas functions, race meetings, fundraisers, or sports matches.

Applications must be lodged no later than 20 days before the event. If you need a special licence over Christmas/New Year, the deadlines are:

- Events in January deadline Friday 19 November
- Events in February deadline 3 December
