Temporary Street Closure - Santa Parade

SH1 and SH94 Proposed Temporary Closure

In conjunction with Waka Kotahi NZ Transport Agency, the Council purposes to close the following streets for the Gore Santa Parade & Christmas in the Park on **Sunday 11 December**.

State Highway

- Medway Street, Gore (SH1) from River Street to Hokonui Drive
- Main Street, Gore (SH1) from the roundabout at Hokonui Drive (SH94) to the roundabout at the Hyde Street/Crombie Street intersection

There will be detours in place via the heavy traffic bypass - SH1 / Hyde Street / River Street and Norfolk Street / Richmond Street / Avon Street / SH94

Local Roads

- Ordsal Street, from Avon Street to Medway Street
- Irwell Street, from Fairfield Street to Ardwick Street

The proposed closure will be from 11:00am to 1:30pm. Irwell Street will be closed from 8:00am to 6:00pm.

Any person objecting to the proposal can lodge their objection and the grounds for it in writing before 5:00pm, **11 November** at Waka Kotahi NZ Transport Agency, Level 2, AA Building, 450 Moray Place, PO Box 5245, Dunedin 9058.
