Criteria for Applicant Eligibility and Selection

1. Eligibility

- a) Current attendance and satisfactory performance at any of the following:
 - Gore High School
 - St Peter's College
 - Blue Mountain College
 - Menzies College
- b) Having resided in the normal catchments of the above schools.
- c) All applicants **MUST** be able to attend the bursary interview.

2. Factors to be considered for selection

- a) An outline by the applicant of their future aims for trade or education.
- b) An outline of reasons why the applicant should be considered for this assistance.
- c) An indication of how this assistance would be utilised.
- d) Supply **one** character reference from a member of the community.
- e) Submit a copy of your NCEA student summary.

3. Trust bursary criteria

- a) The bursary is for the ensuing year only.
- b) There will be three bursaries of \$750.00 each.
- c) The bursary money **must** be used in the immediate year ahead.
- d) Payment will be on proof of appropriate enrolment at an educational facility plus receipts for fees, books or accommodation expenses. Receipts to be received by the Treasurer no later than **31 March 2022**.
- e) The Trust is to be advised immediately if a successful candidate withdraws before the completion of the intended year's study. A time proportional refund will be obligatory.
- f) All information in any application will be treated with full confidentiality by the Trust.
- g) The Trust's decision is final.
