Criteria for the Allocation of Rural Halls and Domains Grants

The total pool of monetary grants available for allocation to Rural Halls and Domain organisations by the Council is set on an annual basis.

Applications for monetary grants are considered using the following criteria:

1. The extent to which they support community outcomes as set out in the Long Term Plan and the Annual Plan.
2. The application being made by a bona fide community or non profit organisation.
3. The applicant being able to demonstrate clearly the need for its service.
4. The applicant being able to identify the likely Gore District community to benefit from the services, activities or projects to be funded. In identifying beneficiaries the organisation needs to demonstrate its relevance and relationship with these beneficiaries.
5. The Council reserving the right to not fund projects or initiatives that are considered the responsibility of central Government.
6. The applicant furnishing the Council with its latest set of annual accounts.
