Thank you for your request for information under the Local Government Official Information and Meetings Act, received by the Gore District Council on 24 February 2025 that asks for the following information:

*all documents in all forms, including those held by outside agencies, relating to:-*

- 1/ The installation and subsequent removal of the carpark on Broughton St immediately outside The Broughton St Discounter.*
- 2/ The erection of the traffic hazard in the middle of Broughton St outside The Broughton St Discounter and its subsequent modification.*
- 3/ The installation by Council of the driveway extension at 84 Broughton St.*
- 4/ The installation and subsequent removal of the 1st carpark on Pomona St immediately alongside The Broughton Street Discounter.*

The Council has previously responded to your request for information on the removal of the carpark on Broughton Street. The Council has no further documentation available on this matter than what has already been provided to you.

With regard to the traffic island installation outside the Broughton Street Discounter, this was provided for through the Streets Alive project funding, and as such information about the traffic island is provided through this documentation. Please find enclosed:
