CEMETERY BYLAW 2008 - AMENDMENT No 1, 2015



Amendment to the Gore District Council Cemetery Bylaw 2008 made in pursuance of the powers contained in the Local Government Act 2002, and pursuant to all other powers, authorities and provisions contained in any other Act enabling the said Council in that behalf:

1. Short Title

<u>The common seal of the Gore</u> District Council was hereunto

The short title of this amendment shall be the Gore District Council Cemeteries Bylaw 2008, Amendment No 1, 2015.

The amendment shall come into operation on the 1st day of September 2015.

1. Clause 1402 – Burials and Sale of Plots to be amended to *include a new* sentence to 1402.1:

1402.1 - Burial plots sold by the Council shall be sold upon the terms and conditions as decided by the Council and the exclusive right of burial may be granted for such limited period as the Council decides. Any relative of a person so buried may, at the time of burial, purchase one adjacent plot at the time of burial only.

In circumstances involving the death of a child, defined as being aged 25 years or under, any relative of a person so buried may, at the time of burial, purchase two additional plots.

The foregoing amendment was duly adopted at a meeting of the Gore District Council held on the 11th day of August 2008 and ordered to come into force on the 1st day of September 2015.
