

## Mataura Water Treatment Plant Upgrade

The Council has started a \$3.5million upgrade of Mataura's water treatment plant to ensure drinking water to the town's residents meets national standards.

There should be minimal disruption to Mataura's water supply. However, there will be aspects of the work that will impact on the capacity of the treatment plant.

This includes refurbishing of the plant's two filters, which starts on Monday 17 April.

The Council expects to be able to keep up with demand. However, if demand starts exceeding what can be treated it may result in residents being asked to conserve water.

## Road Closure for Tree Removal

River Street will be closed from the intersection with Medway Street to Oldham Street from 6:00am Saturday 15 April to 6:00pm Sunday 16 April.

The closure is to allow Environment Southland to remove large Poplar trees on the stop bank.

All traffic will be diverted along SH1 Main Street.
