

Southern Field Days Traffic Information

The busiest three days on our roads are coming up with Southern Field Days. To help with traffic flow, the following restrictions will be in place **Wednesday 14 February to Friday 16 February, between 7:00am and 7:00pm.**

- Waimumu Road will be open only to field days traffic, no through traffic except for emergency services and school buses.
- Salford Street is closed to westbound traffic at the intersection with SH1

There will be temporary traffic lights at the following intersections

- Charlton Road and SH1
- Broughton Street and SH1
- Waimumu Road, at the intersection with Humphries and Lady Charlton roads
- Lady Charlton Road, at the intersection with Waimumu Road
- Humphries Road, at the intersection with Waimumu Road
- Waimumu Road and Glendhu Road

Gore Bridge Footpath Closure

The footpath on the northern side of the Gore bridge will be closed from:

- early February until the end of March.

The closure is due to the renewal of an old asbestos wastewater pipeline under the footpath, which has reached the end of its life.

Pedestrians will have to use the southern footpath. There will be a temporary walkway under the bridge on the eastern side to ensure people's safety.

Latham Lane will also be closed to through traffic. Access to River Terrace will be available via Huron Street.

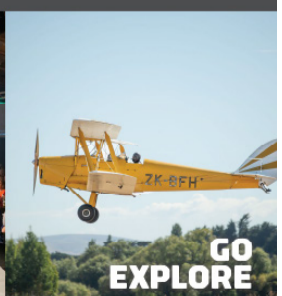
